### Winter Games: Snow Much Fun

The snowshoe season this year was memorable, not only in St. Mary's County, but also in the mountains at Wisp Resort. For the first time in 5 years, athletes were able to practice snowshoeing on actual snow in St. Mary's County. And, when they went to Wisp for Winter Games, there was more snow than ever before. Ten local athletes and six partners competed in 50 meter, 100 meter, and 200 me-

Unified Partners Paul Guy and Jackie Fowler ran with athletes Russell Bucci and Melody Chase. They won a silver medal. Athletes Michelle Johnson and Michael Nahrgang, only 8 years old, competed with partners Courtney Fowler and Connie Thompson to win the gold medal. Jason Wright and Laura Marini were accompanied by our newest partners Shaun Carroll and Marissa Parlock. They also achieved the gold in their race.

Our traditional relay team also smoked the competition. They are Austin De-beltz, Stephen Maras, Andy Thompson, and Justin Fowler. With so many medal winners, we had to get a big bus to drive them home.

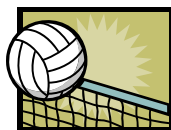

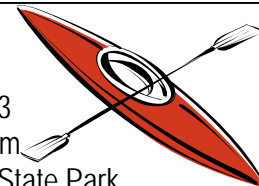

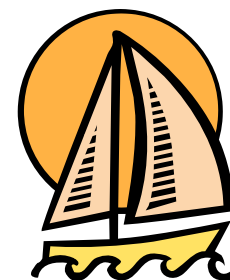
